



# AMATEUR BASEBALL FEDERATION OF INDIA

**1 Roll Call:**

The attendance of participant was ensured on the attendance registered.

**2 To approve the resignation tendered by Shri Pankaj Lochan Mohanty President ABFI:**

The Chair Person Mr. Ramakant Angle put up the resignation of Mr. Pankaj Lochan Mohanty as president of ABFI for confirmation of house. Member present unanimous accepted the resignation of Mr. Pankaj Lochan Mohanty.

**2 To decide the name of Acting President of ABFI:**

The Chair Person Mr. Ramakant Angle had forward the agenda of electing acting president of ABFI to fill the vacant position of President of ABFI. Mr. Ashok sharma President of Rajasthan Baseball Association proposed the name of Mr. M.N Krishnamurthy for president post seconded by Mr. P.C Bhardwaj member present of general house unanimously passed the resolution.

Mr. P.C Bhardwaj welcomed the Mr. Krishnamurthy with flower bouquet. All member present welcomed Mr. Krishnamurthy as president of ABFI. Mr. Harish Kumar requested elected president to take chair on Dias and preside over the meeting

**3 Any other Matter with the Permission of Chair:**


Mr. Jahar Dass Secretary General of West Bengal put up the resolution to take action Against Mr. U.N Challu for anti ABFI activities as declaring himself as the acting president of ABFI and misguiding ABFI affiliated unit in India and at International level. Mr. Jahar Dass suggested 6 year suspension to Mr. U.N Challu seconded by Mr. Rajendra Ikhankar. The house unanimously passed the resolution.


Mr. Rajendra Ikhankar secretary Maharashtra put up resolution to take disciplinary action against H.P Secretary Mr, Manoj Kohli for violating regulation of ABFI and for misguiding ABFI fraternity in India and at International level by passing wrong information. Mr. Jahar Dass and Miss Mitali Ghosh supported resolution. House passed the resolution unanimously.

Mr. Jahar Dass brought in to the notice of General House the J&K department of sports derecognise the Jammu & Kashmir Baseball Association. Mr. Krishnamurthy President ABFI authorised Mr. Ashok Kumar Sharma and committee under him to enquire the Jammu & Kashmir Baseball Association matter and submit its report.

Mrs Shweta asked for clarification on Sub Junior National Baseball Championship to be organised in Assam. Mr. Harish Kumar told SGM member that it is not possible to cancel the Championship at this stage and shall be conducted as per schedule.

Mr. Jahar Dass Secretary General of West Bengal put up the resolution to disaffiliate Tripura Baseball Association. Tripura Baseball team never participated in any of the championship





and also never paid annual fees of ABFI. Resolution seconded by Mr. Rajendra Ikhankar secretary Maharashtra and house unanimously passed the resolution.

Mr.S.N Pradhan suggested that since the past account and bank details are not submitted by Treasurer Mr.BPS Rana and then the secretary General Mr. Sudhir Mohindru action to be taken against both.

Mr. Krishnamurthy suggested to issue show cause notice to both on 30 days' time and take action accordingly .House unanimously passed the resolution.


Mr. Rajendra Ikhankar suggested that record of money paid by the players for participation in Pakistan, Korea and Dubai tour should come in ABFI account.

Mr.S.N Pradhan put one resolution of nominating Mr.P.C Bhardwaj as an Executive Director. Mr. Ramakant Angle said that there is no need of such post as ABFI have elected Secretary General and EC who can work potentially for the betterment of baseball Mr. Indukiran also supported Mr. Angle's suggestion. Mr.P.C Bhardwaj said if General house don't support and rejected this proposal he also does not accept the ED post. Entire house unanimously scrapped the Executive Director Post for ever.

**President Address:**



The meeting was presided by ABFI President Mr. Pankaj Lochan Mohanty. The President informed the house that though the Secretary General Dr. Sudhir Mohindru is present in the hotel, he is not in a position to join due to illness. He welcomed all the members present and the meeting was called to order. The following matters were discussed:

**1. ROLL CALL:**

Attendance of participants was ensured in the Attendance Register.

**2. PRESIDENT'S ADDRESS:**

The President, ABFI, Mr. Pankaj Lochan Mohanty welcomed the members present and invited the honorary dignitaries on the dais to address the house.

- i. Chairman Mr. Ashok Pattan: Mr. Ashok Pattan informed that he was not expecting an election for the post of Secretary General. He said that since our game is not so popular in our country, we should not adopt political systems and must work in unison. All energy and finances used for elections should be used for promotion of the game. If we indulge in conflicts and infighting, we will spoil our reputation and our players shall have to suffer. He said that we should try to generate enough finance so that the players may not have to contribute for International Participations. He again reiterated the need of not have any personal grudges or enmity and said that for future we must sit and try to give unanimous nominations.
- ii. Chief Patron Mr. Ramakant Angle: Mr. Ramakant Angle in his speech advised that our Target should be nothing less that Olympic. We have talent. He recalled that in 2012, our U15 team delivered an easy defeat to world leader Japan. He said that he is proud of India because it is a great country. Tomorrow belongs to us. We must stay united and work to generate sizeable money. Each drop contributes towards an ocean. He said that he wants to see India as No. 1 in Baseball. We have that capacity. We should try new game formats like T20. He assured all possible support to the Federation. He said Baseball runs in my blood.
- iii. Patron Mr. Jasraj Mehta: Mr. Mehta said that though we are divided in groups during elections, we must try to remain intact afterwards. He said Baseball has seen a good progress in the past years but we must not satisfy ourselves and work for betterment of Baseball in India with the help of stalwarts like Mr. Angle, Mr. Ashok Pattan and Mr. Pankaj Lochan Mohanty.
- iv. President Mr. Pankaj Lochan Mohanty: Mr. Mohanty thanked the dignitaries for their words of encouragement and informed that the elctions are being



conducted in a very friendly environment and all members have been accommodated in the same hotel. This is to avoid any group-ism.

### **3. SECRETARY GENERAL'S REPORT:**

The Secretary general Dr. Sudhir Mohindru's Report was read out by Mr. BPS Rana.

In his report, Secretary General Mr. Sudhir Mohindru informed that during the year gone, we made a steady progress and we could manage to complete our calendar of events as per schedule.

He informed that our U12 team participated in the X U12 Asian Championship at Taiwan and our young players defeated Srilanka. Though Srilanka is more than 20 ranks above India in WBSC ranking.

He further informed that our 5 young players participated in World Children's Baseball Fair 2017 at Yokohama, Japan from 8th August 2017 to 16th August 2017.

He did not hesitate in accepting that Presidential Cup at Assam turned out to be not so good show with participation only 3 international teams against initial confirmation of 8 teams.

In the end, he thanked every member for the love and support extended to him during his tenure as Secretary General and offered apologies if he ever hurt sentiments of anybody during performance of his duties.

The members welcomed the report.

### **4. CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING:**

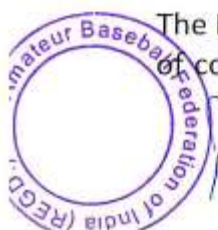
The President informed that the minutes of previous General Meeting held at Bhubaneswar were circulated among members and sought approval of the same.

The President informed that there has been some technical hitch in granting affiliation to Baseball Association Telangana and we shall have to get reconfirmation & approval of house once again before finalizing the minutes and giving permanent affiliation to Baseball Association of Telengana, Mrs. Shweta Sengupta as General Secretary. The affiliation to Baseball Association of Telengana, General Secretary Mrs. Shweta Sengupta was approved by majority vote.

The minutes were approved by the house unanimously.

### **5. ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR 2016-17 & 2017-18:**

The House was informed that the accounts could not be completed due to some gap of communication and the same shall be completed by end of December 2018 and

Mr. Khadodhara further demanded that though the voting is to start within 2 hours, the list of candidate has still not published. It is not proper. The president informed that the list of Candidates has already been prepared and displayed and Election is going to be conducted in a free and fair manner.

The President thanked the members and the meeting was adjourned.
